Pool Rules

Your Safety is Our First Priority.

- Parents or guardians are responsible for supervising their children. Lifeguards are on duty to enforce rules and to respond in case of an emergency.
- Breath holding and prolonged submersion is not permitted.
- Rough play, unsafe actions & improper behavior are not permitted. (NO running on the pool deck, dunking, pushing, playing on backs and shoulders, fighting, flips or profanity/vulgar language).
- Diving is not permitted.
- Flotation devices must be US CoastGuard (USCG) approved devices, NO arm floats.
- Proper swim attire is required, No thong cut suits, cut off jeans, or undergarments.
- Children not yet potty trained must wear tight fitting swim diapers in the pool and pool area and no diapers may be changed on the pool deck.
- Smoking, Vaping, and Glass containers and Alcohol consumption are not permitted on premises. - Offenders will be asked to leave immediately.
- Safety Depth Marker Rope is always to remain in the pool.
- Do not hang or swim over lane lines and safety lines.
- To ensure the safety of all, YMCA staff reserve the right to remove a patron from the pool if he or she is behaving in an unsafe or inappropriate manner.
- The Lifeguard's word is FINAL.

Age Guidelines -

- Children ages 10-15 can use the pool independently, for up to 3 hours at a time.
- Children ages 9 and under must be supervised by a parent or guardian (16 years or older).
- Children 6 and under **MUST** be accompanied in the pool in the water at **ALL** times by a parent or guardian (16 years or older).

Group Ratios -

- Children ages 5 and under must have a ratio of 1 adult to every 3 children in the water with them.
- Children 6-9 must have ratio of 1 adult to every 8 children and must be supervised at all times.

Deep End Rules -

- All swimmers younger than 16 must pass a swim test in order to use the deep areas of the pool.

Slide Rules -

- All slide users must be 48 inches or taller per State Code.
- All participants younger than 18 will be given a wrist band showing their eligibility for slide use.
