





Calls For Service

Between January 1 and April 30, 2018, Officers and Dispatchers handled **2,414** citizen calls for public safety services. Officers also initiated **2,149** items of activity, for a combined total of <u>4,563</u> events of activity.


Of the total public safety calls received in the first four months of 2018 by EPD dispatchers, **660** were for Emergency Medical and\or Fire Services, and 367 calls were received as a **911** call.





Traffic Violations

Between January 1 and April 30, 2018 Officers of the Eaton Police Division issued <u>88</u> citations. Each citation corresponds to a violation of City or State traffic laws. The blue line in the graph below represents the monthly break down of the citations filed by the Eaton Police Division in the 1st four months of 2018. The red line represents the breakdown of citations filed by the Eaton Police Division in the 1st four months of 2017. Most of the citations stemmed from <u>319</u> traffic stops and <u>81</u> motor vehicle crashes during the first four months of 2018.




Motor Vehicle Crashes


